By sending your documents to Perry International, you understand and agree to all of the terms and conditions below.

Perry International is a private company. We are not associated with any US or foreign government offices. The decision to issue a passport or visa is completely up to the issuing office. Visas do not guarantee entry into another country. Entrance is always at the discretion of an immigration officer at the port of arrival.

Perry International does not guarantee that any government office will issue a passport or visa in a timely manner. Our liability is limited to work that is in our care. We are not responsible for the delay or damage of documents due to any other government office or delivery company.

All fees, processing times and requirements are estimates based on our most recent information and are subject to change without notice. All fees will be non-refundable once an application is submitted to the issuing office regardless of denial or delay of documentation or cancellation or alteration of your trip.

Consulates reserves the right to request additional documents, to call the applicants for an interview and to ask questions on personal, financial, business, or corporate related issues.

Perry International service charges are based on the receipt of all required documents, completely filled out and received in our office before 10:00 am. Any documents received that do not meet these conditions are subject to additional charges. Any additional services required due to a mistake or delay by another office may require additional charges.

For U.S. passport applications with a departure date or a want back date within 6 weeks, the U.S. State Department's \$60 expedite fee will be paid and charged to the applicant.

We will use our Federal Express account to return your documents unless you send us a completely filled out label to use for the return.
